subsequently referred to as "Mr. Ruiz"

The parties agree upon the following:

## Preamble

In the year 2000 Mr. Ruiz produced the series "Global Cities" broadcasted on television in 43 countries. With separate 25 minute episodes this series documents the impact of international migration in six global cities: New York, London, Tokyo, Frankfurt, Mexico City, Toronto.

Now that migration has become one of the most important and pressing global issues of our time Mr. Ruiz is preparing a second round of "Global Cities".

In 2016 he will begin with a remake of TORONTO: A World in a City. This remake will feature the same multicultural characters from two decades ago, and it will document how they have adjusted to life in Toronto while at the same time helping to change the city.

Later on in 2016/2017 Mr. Ruiz will produce remakes of the other "Global Cities" New York, London, Tokyo, Frankfurt, and Mexico City.



## § 1

### Obligations rmtv

rmtv agrees to upload and broadcast the series "Global Cities" produced by Mr. Ruiz via its cable network in the German State of Hessian by provider Unity Media, via Astra satellite covering the whole of Europe by provider Media Broadcast, and via internet with global livestream and media center.

In total rmtv has a technical coverage of around 150 million viewers in whole Europe. In addition there are the users that only view reports via internet. Livestream and media center are integrated in rmtv's webpage and accessible without entry restrictions from all over the world. All videos are uploaded in rmtv's media center directly after being broadcasted and can be watched by everyone (without temporal limitation – that means that the videos are not deleted automatically after a certain period of time). Via livestream the whole program content is distributed parallel and identically to the broadcasted television program 24/7. Therefore program of rmtv is available all around the world any time. rmtv also uses facebook and youtube as distribution channels. rmtv will upload the series on its social media channels as well to make sure to reach its young and "online" audience.

## § 2

### Obligations Mr. Ruiz

Mr. Ruiz agrees to produce and provide rmtv with six episodes of "Global Cities". Mr. Ruiz will transfer each episode via ftp-server to rmtv in appropriate format related to the technical coding guidelines of rmtv latest six days before broadcasting.
